Emergency Care

As a trauma-certified hospital serving eastern Montana, Holy Rosary doctors are trained in emergency medicine, and all

its nurses are trained and certified in advanced cardiac life support (ACLS), pediatric advanced life support (PALS) and the trauma nursing core curriculum. The onsite surgery center, diagnostic imaging services, and ICU support optimal care in the ER. The hospital also works closely with our sister hospital, St. Vincent Healthcare, located in Billings, MT, which offers fixed wing and helicopter ambulance transportation for the most acute patients.



Primary & Specialty Care

Leveraging the expertise of the SCL Health network, Holy Rosary has an impressive medical staff comprised of

primary and speciality care physicians to provide onsite access to the care patients need including family and internal medicine, pediatrics, general surgery, women's health, heart and vascular care, cancer care, and neurosciences, among others. Care is delivered onsite and virtually through a robust telemedicine network allowing patients local access to quality health care.



Residential Living

In addition to hospital care, Holy Rosary also provides skilled nursing and long term care for short-term transitional stays after illness, injury or surgery as

well as healthy living opportunities for patients who require 24/7 nursing support. Holy Rosary Residential Living is dedicated to safe, effective, high-quality services for those it serves.
