Heart & Vascular

The SCL Health Heart & Vascular Center at St. Vincent is home to one of the regions most comprehensive cardiac and vascular programs. From diagnosis to rehabilitation, St. Vincent offers an extensive variety of heart and vascular procedures. St. Vincent is one of only two hospitals in the state

of Montana to be designated an Accredited Chest Pain Center by the American College of Cardiology. St. Vincent offers several minimally invasive procedures such as Transcatherer Aortic Valve Replacement (TAVR), MitraClip and Watchman.



Pediatrics

St. Vincent Healthcare offers a hospital within a hospital just for kids, including the state's first 24/7 Pediatric Intensive Care Unit, a comprehensive list of board-certified pediatric specialists and subspecialists, a pediatric surgery program, multidisciplinary pediatric specialty clinics,

and nurses specially trained to care for the most critical needs of our children. We have also teamed up with Primary Children's Hospital in Salt Lake City, Utah to ensure the best pediatric care is available to all children in Montana and Northern Wyoming.



Orthopedics & Spine

St. Vincent offers a full-range of orthopedic and spine services including sports medicine, total joint replacement, pediatric orthopedics, podiatry and more. The program focuses on nonsurgical and minimally invasive intervention but is also nationally recognized for hip and knee replacement surgery.



Neurosciences

St. Vincent Healthcare is a Certified Primary Stroke Center by the Joint Commission and is the only Certified MS Center in the state of Montana. Our Regional Neuroscience Center is the most comprehensive in the region and was the first hospital in the state to perform Deep Brain Stimulation surgery. St. Vincent offers a full range of neurology and neurosurgery services.



Women's Health

St. Vincent Healthcare offers an array of women's services to meet the needs of the whole person. Comprehensive care includes a Mother Newborn Care Unit, a Level III Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, state of the art digital mammography services, a high-risk pregnancy program,

a midwifery program, and world-class obstetrical care. In addition, specially-trained surgeons offer minimally invasive robotic surgery for hysterectomy and other women's gynecological procedures.



Cancer Care

The oncology specialists at the SCL Health Cancer Centers of Montana at St. Vincent Healthcare are skilled in treating all forms of cancer by creating personalized care plans. Our comprehensive oncology services begin with prevention and screening, and include chemotherapy and

infusion, radiation therapy including CyberKnife Robotic Radiosurgery, and surgical interventions. Our clinical trial program is the most robust in the state of Montana.



Emergency & Trauma Care

St. Vincent Healthcare's Level II Emergency & Trauma Center brings patients and their loved ones the most skilled services and highest technology available in the area. We provide a full range of specialized

care, including lab and pharmacy in the ER, dedicated radiology services, Certified Primary Stroke Center, Accredited Chest Pain Center, and telemedicine services. Our HELP Flight program offers helicopter and fixed-wing transport through the region.
